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Carry small go bags- water or hand warmers, freeze dried foods, super lightweight and does not take a lot to do.

Other jurisdictions have a person who coordinates services between different agencies-will assign areas and who is providing what. Also, great tool to use to communicate information regarding people served. This is a paid position.

I'd have already cleared them out if I weren't sick. TMAC can contribute some money for street teams without funding wanting to pick some stuff up.

Need to transfer to smaller bottles. Surprisingly few tent fires from hand sanitizer; people are usually awake and monitoring flame. Small blue flames are safe but fires happen when people mix in other items to burn. Tent fires draw public attention and escalate fears and blame. Hygiene/cold weather mixed kits are well received. bagsinbulk.com a great source for discount blankets, etc. Salvation Army collecting cold weather gear to hand out.
