· Often, the services offered at the Salvation Army are the service the Salvation Army itself provides; they don't do a lot of referrals out. Part of the reason for not referring is the lack of a good resource list, since resources are constantly changing.

· City of Tacoma Equity and Human Rights department can only refer because it has no resources. The end of PC rent assistance was a big blow and Tacoma pro bono is short-staffed.

· New Hope Resource Center has a Safe Parking program affiliated with local churches that puts people on a 30-60-90-day program with rehabilitative tasks to perform. There are requirements for the program, like tabs for vehicle and no felonies. Safe Parking should be considered as a resource for houseless people with cars.
