






Current Program Enrollments







Location of Episodes Started in past week










Pierce County Homeless System and Annual throughput (based on most recent 12 months)

Coordinated Entry is the first step in ending homelessness. Coordinated Entry is available on demand in three different ways:


- Call 211 for live support or to schedule an appointment. The phone line is staffed Monday through Friday from 9am-4pm. Speak
